### **Building 'Crumbling'**

FLINDERS Ports says the Mission to Seamen is unsafe and too dilapidated to restore.

``It's crumbling and it's going to fall down and we're concerned someone will get hurt," said Flinders Ports chief executive Vincent Tremaine.

``It's really in a bad state of disrepair, it's impossible (to restore) it's too far gone. Once it was burnt it really damaged it.

Flinders Ports would install a permanent memorial to the building near the old Pilot Station at Outer Harbor. It also would save building materials from the demolition.
