Liners arrive at the double

ADELAIDE will host cruise ships on consecutive days - the Star Princess due in this morning, followed at Outer Harbor by the Superstar Leo tomorrow.

The visits are part of 12 cruise ship arrivals this summer.

The South Australian Tourism Commission says this is a record, totalling 17,700 passengers and 7000 crew.

The large, 18-storey Star Princess already has been here twice this summer, and will call for a fourth time on February 10.

The Star Princess is due from 6am until sailing at 6pm today.

The Superstar Leo is due from 7am until 8pm tomorrow.

Due to international security protocols, Flinders Ports cannot allow any public access to the wharf or to the passenger terminal.
