\$18m Harbor expansion

A MULTI-MILLION dollar extension to the berth at the Outer Harbor container terminal is planned to help it cope with larger ships.

The berth will be extended by 149m to become 660m long, at a cost of about \$18 million. The year-long project will begin in the next few months.

Flinders Ports chief executive Vincent Tremaine said ships coming into Outer Harbor were getting bigger. ``Growth has been tremendous in terms of the number of ships," he said.
