\$12.5m crane a port first

A \$12.5 MILLION crane yesterday became the new centrepiece of Outer Harbor's container terminal.

The Post-Panamax crane arrived by ship and will be assembled as soon as possible. It is the first of its kind in Adelaide.

The major investment by co-owners DP World and Flinders Ports will give the terminal a productivity boost.

The crane will have the capacity to "twin-lift" two 6m containers at the same time, and at faster operational speeds.
