

Privacy Collection Statement

Flinders Ports is committed to ensuring that the privacy of visitors to the organisation's website is maintained.

This Privacy Collection Statement outlines the nature of personal information collected from the Flinders Ports website and how it is used. Flinders Ports does not collect personal information from this site, other than information provided through our Feedback, Tenders and Contracts, Application for Use of Port Facilities forms; and Contact emails.

Flinders Ports will only use personal information obtained from the website in instances where it is required to:

- provide a response to individuals who have submitted feedback or a request for information
- acknowledge responses, and provide further detail, relating to specific tenders and contracts of interest
- add individuals to a mailing list notifying of release dates for the Flinders RePort electronic newsletter - as prompted by the individual

Website Statistics

This site does not employ the use of cookies.

Web statistics are collected and analysed at an aggregate level ensuring visitor anonymity. Statistics are used in determining patterns of access for the purpose of refining and further developing the site.

Non-identifying statistics logged include;

- Visits – number of unique visits
- Domain name of account used to access the site
- Browser used and operating system
- Where connected to site from
- Pages accessed and downloaded
